Ancient functional ceramics: Mechanical and thermal performance

Abstract:

Ceramics were among the first functional materials fabricated by people. They were used for manifold purposes, such as storage, transport, food processing, construction or pyrotechnology. For each different function they had to withstand different types of loads, mechanical as well as thermal. Evidence from archaeological ceramics indicates that the production process and the ceramic design were adapted in order to achieve specific performance characteristics. Examples of ancient functional ceramics will be presented combined with results of material testing. The resulting material properties will be interpreted with computer simulations of microstructure and vessel design.
