Abstract

EIT RawMaterials is the largest consortium in the raw materials sector worldwide initiated and funded by the EIT (European Institute of Innovation and Technology), a body of the European Union and part of the H2020 programme. The EIT mission is to develop raw materials into a major strength for Europe and to enable sustainable competitiveness of the European minerals, metals and materials. Partners of EIT RawMaterials are active across the entire raw materials value chain; from exploration, mining and mineral processing to substitution, recycling and circular economy. They collaborate on finding new, innovative solutions to secure the supplies and improve the raw materials sector in Europe. The EIT is the first EU initiative bringing together the three sides of the 'knowledge triangle': Business (companies and SMEs), Higher Education Institutions and Research Centres. The Raw Materials Academy strives to educate the raw materials game-changers of the future and ensure that Europe cultivates a society of learners contributing to a strong EU raw materials base.

The seminar will explain the structure of EIT Raw Materials and illustrate initiatives and possibilities to researchers and students in the education sector (e.g., wider society learning, Msc and Phd education, lifelong learning) and in business creation.
